## CHEROKEE LAKE SAILING CLUB TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

**Cherokee Lake Sailing Club offers two levels of membership:** 

- Regular Membership
- Associate Membership

A <u>Regular Membership</u> gives privileges to a person who is eighteen years of age who is presently the <u>owner or co-owner of a sailboat</u>.

This includes membership privileges for the active member's family. A member of an active member's family is a spouse or person who is a dependent. *(under IRS regulations)* of an active member. A family may cast one vote in club matters.

The dues for this membership is \$100 annually, payable January 1<sup>st</sup>.

An <u>Associate Membership</u> is given to a person interested in sailing but is <u>not an owner of a sailboat</u>. An associate member and a family member shall be afforded all the rights and privileges of a regular member with the following exceptions below:

- Voting on certain CLSC matters may be restricted by the Board of Directors.
- New Associate Members may be restricted by the Board.

The dues for this membership is \$50 annually, payable January 1<sup>st</sup>.
